Family Code of Conduct

Parents of swimmers on the MVP Dolphins Swim Team agree to follow the guidelines for conduct outlined below.

Practice teamwork with all parents, swimmers, and coaches by supporting the values of Discipline, Loyalty, Commitment, and Hard Work.

Refrain from coaching or instructing the team or any swimmer at a practice or meets (from the stands or any other area) or from interfering with coaches on the pool deck.

Demonstrate good sportsmanship by conducting yourself in a manner that earns the respect of your child, other swimmers, parents, officials, and the coaches at meets and practices.

Maintain self-control at all times. Know your role.

Understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward the coaches, officials, and/or any participating swimmer is not permitted or tolerated.

During competitions, direct questions or concerns regarding decisions made by meet officials to a member of our coaching staff. Address officials via the coaching staff only.
